The Lion and the Bible

The Lion is mentioned in the Bible more often than any other undomesticated animal. It is named 157 times in 31 of the 66 books of the Bible. Lions are treated in the Bible both as natural animals and as symbols of power and strength. The lion was the ensign of the tribe of Judah, and was used by Solomon in the decoration of his house and the temple.
